_____ If approved, I agree that to maintain my status as a Range Officer, I will 1) uphold the Bylaws of the Big Salty Range, 2) abide by the Range Rules and Range Officer Rules as approved by the Big Salty Range Committee, 3) contribute at least 12 hours per year of public service to the Range, 4) participate in at least two range club monthly matches per year, and 5) conduct myself accordingly as a representative of the Big Salty Range. I will reserve range time on the Range website (bigsalty.org), and have all guests sign waivers at the pavilion and pay the appropriate fees. I will not divulge any range related access code to anyone else. I agree that my Range Officer status may be terminated if I fail to abide by the above conditions.

_____ I am not a restricted person and I am not prohibited from owning or possessing a firearm.

I agree to protect, indemnify, save and hold harmless the Utah Division of Wildlife Resources, its Director, employees, agents, volunteers, all participating sponsor organizations, concessionaire of the Big Salty Range and its member clubs, club members, competitors, sponsors, and participants from and against all claims, demands, damages, and causes of action of every kind or character arising because of, for, out of, or in any way connected with my attendance at the Big Salty Shooting Range, unless caused by the sole negligence of the aforementioned range parties. I agree to defend all suits brought upon such claims and pay all costs and expenses incidental thereto, but the aforementioned range parties shall have the right, at their option, to participate in the defense incidental thereto without relieving me of an obligation hereunder.

Big Salty Range Rules

1. Big Salty is a cold range. Firearms may only be loaded at the direction of a Range Officer.
2. Firearms may only be handled at designated "Safety Areas" or at the firing line under the supervision of a Range Officer. Otherwise, they must be kept unloaded in a secure bag, case, or holster.
3. Shooting is only permitted during official scheduled matches and events, or during practice scheduled by Big Salty Range Officers on the Range Officer calendar. You must be a Big Salty RO to gain access to the online reservations.
4. All shooters must date, note the supervising RO or training organization, and sign the liability waiver and pay the appropriate fees.
5. Range Officer practice fees are \$5.00 for a Range RO & \$10.00 for each guest. Children under 18 shoot for free and must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
6. Shooting is only permitted during daylight hours. Shooting is not allowed more than 30 minutes before sunrise or 30 minutes after sunset.
7. Ammunition may NOT be handled in the "Safety Areas". This also includes anything resembling ammo, such as spent cases, snap caps, dummy rounds, etc.
8. Eye and ear protection is required for all shooters and spectators.
9. All persons anywhere on the range must be accompanied by a Big Salty Range Officer except during a match.
10. Fully Automatic firearms are prohibited on the range.
11. Non-prescription drugs and alcohol are prohibited on the range.
12. Rifle calibers greater than 5.56 mm are prohibited on the range, cowboy calibers excluded.
13. The Big Salty Range observes the "180" rule. Keep your muzzle pointed down range or you will be asked to leave.
14. Negligent Discharges that leave the range (shots that go over a back or East berm) must be reported to the range at (385) 212-4946.
15. Be safe and have fun. The Big Salty Range is a scarce resource this close to the city. Please exercise caution during events and practice.

Range Officer Rules

In addition to the Big Salty Range rules, ROs reserving bays must follow these additional rules.

1. When using the range for practice:
 - a. When entering, close the gate behind you to keep out unwanted individuals. We have had issues with this in the past.
 - b. Raise the red flag on the telephone pole at the entrance if it is not up already.
 - c. When leaving the range, if you are the last person to leave the range, please lower the flag and place it in the box and lock the gate. Make sure there are no other people on the range, so they don't get locked in.
2. No parking in bays. No driving in bays when the ground is wet.
3. Respect the Range, Respect Yourself, and Respect Others. If you see something wrong do something about it. Leave things cleaner than you found them.
4. If it cannot be done at a Match, it cannot be done while you are using a bay (e.g., shooting into berm while others shoot downrange, walking behind others with a loaded gun out of the holster or case). Use your head.
5. No handling of firearms when people are forward of the firing line and/or down range. All firearms must have safeties on, and be holstered, bagged, or muzzle up as appropriate.
6. All targets must be placed in a manner so all rounds will impact a berm and not the range floor. Rounds that hit the range floor will skip off and go over the back berm.
7. All shooters are responsible for their rounds staying within the confines of this range. This includes rounds deflected off the range floor or steel targets.
8. Personal steel targets MUST deflect rounds downwards to the range floor.
9. If you muzzle anyone with a firearm (loaded or not), including yourself, you will be asked to leave the range.
10. Exception to maximum caliber rule: Rifle calibers larger than 5.56 mm can be shot by range ROs but the RO must reserve the 100 yard "Scope Registration Bay".

A violation of any rule will result in a 30-day suspension of Range privileges; subsequent violations will result in the Big Salty Range Board determining the course of action, up to and including permanent ineligibility to shoot at the Range.
